### Conditions of Entry:

- o All entries must be paid in full and accompany a General Entry Form
- o ENTRIES CLOSE AT 10:00AM SATURDAY 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2023. This will be strictly adhered to. no late entries accepted.
- o Exhibitors MUST, complete ENTRY FORM.
- o All exhibitors with the exception of those who are Stewards must vacate Pavilion by 10:15am.
  - o Exhibits will be judged according to standards set out by the Royal Horticultural Society of NSW.
- o Judging will commence at 10:30am and the Judges decision will be final in all classes,
- o All plants and cut flowers in this section must be grown by and be the property of the exhibitor, for at least 3 months. Except Section D-Decorative.
- o Entries may be entered at the Horticulture Pavilion at the Showground from 3-6pm Friday and from 8:00am to 10:00am on Saturday morning of the Show.
- o Entries must be collected between 9am and 12:00 noon Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2023,
- o Entries not collected by 12:00 noon Sunday will be left outside of Horticulture Pavilion,
- o Points will be awarded for the Most Successful Exhibitors and Runner Up
- o NND - Not Necessarily Distinct & Distinct — Different.

### SECTION A - MISCELLANEOUS

**PLEASE NOTE:** Blooms listed in other sections not eligible.

- 180. Flowering shrub or tree, two cuts of one variety
  - 181. Flowering creeper, two cuts of one variety
  - 182. Australian native, one cut of any native
  - 183. Dahlia, one stem any variety
  - 184. Dahlia, three stems of one variety
  - 185. Dahlia, three stems of mixed varieties
  - 186. Geranium, one stem
  - 187. Geranium, three stems
  - 188. Any flower not mentioned, three cuts
  - 189. Specimen cut or stem of flower not mentioned
- Champion exhibit (ribbon)

### SECTION B - POT PLANTS

All pots to be no more than 35.5cm (14 inches) across top (inside measurement), hanging containers excluded. Only one plant per pot, unless stated otherwise.

- 190. Pot plant, indoor
  - 191. Pot plant, outdoor
  - 192. Pot plant, fern
  - 193. Pot plant, cactus or succulent, one only
  - 194. Pot plant, cactus or succulent, three or more in container.
  - 195. Hanging pot plant, succulent
  - 196. Hanging pot plant, in bloom
  - 197. Hanging pot plant, fern
- Champion pot plant (ribbon)

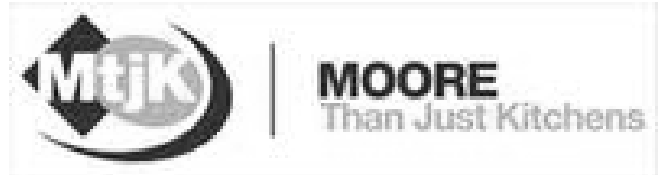

### SECTION C - ROSES

Foliage to be shown.

- 198. Specimen rose, one stem
- 199. Specimen rose, one stem, two or more colours
- 200. Roses, three stems, one variety
- 201. Roses, three stems, mixed varieties
- 202. Bud to full bloom, three stages
- Champion rose (ribbon)



### SECTION D - ARRANGEMENTS

- 203. Frontal arrangement of mixed flowers Flowers — at least three varieties  
**Prize money for class 203 only 1<sup>st</sup> 200 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2.50**
- 204. Centrepiece arrangement, traditional style
- 205. Leaf arrangement
- 206. Freestyle arrangement, non natural materials may be used
- 207. Weed arrangement, any variety
- Champion arrangement (ribbon)

### SECTION E — CHILDREN

All entries in Section F must be the work of the child entering these classes.

- 208. Posy — posy to be in water, ribbon etc. allowed
- 209. Vegetable and/or fruit novelty — work to be firm and secure for display.
- 210. Recycled containers — Any medium e.g. used wooden box, jam jar, milo tin, milk bottle, hollow log etc.  
Plants can be flowers succulents, herbs or plant of any type.
- 211. Pot of herb, salad mix, vegetable or flower
- Champion child exhibitor (ribbon)
