

Manilla paper Plane contest

This Event is run by the Manilla Show society and the event will be held in the

Manilla Free Kid's Zone 9am Saturday 11th March, 2023

This event is designed as a game fun and of skill. It is free of charge and only subject to the present Terms and to all applicable regional laws and regulations.

By entering and participating in this event, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and represent that you satisfy all of the requirements.

Use caution and common sense when participating in this event. Respect and ensure the safety of yourself and others. Do not trespass or harm anyone's property.

Eligibility

In order to enter this event and be eligible to win a reward, you confirm that you satisfy the following eligibility criteria.

1. You acknowledge that you have to provide an entry form with name age and address.
2. You are permitted to enter into more than one category, however you are not permitted to win more than one reward in this event. An alternative winner will be selected if you enter into and win more than one Category.
3. The decision of the Judges is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into. Due to the expected high number of entries, individual feedback is not possible.
4. The Organizer will contact each winner to notify them that they have won a reward.

Winner selection

On Saturday the 11 March a panel of qualified judges will select the winner of each category from among the eligible entrants.

The selected winner is subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these rules.
Limit one (1) prize per person.

Please note that the results and name of each winner selected by the Judges will be displayed in the local Newspaper Manilla Express.

At any time during the event, the Organizer reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify and remove any Entrant for any failure to observe these terms (including but not limited to, because Organizer believes the Entrant engaged in cheating or any other kind of illegal or inappropriate behaviour and general violations set out in these Terms.

General

If any provision of the Terms shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions of the Terms shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

Paper Airplane Contest Rules

The Judging panel will judge the entries based on the three following categories.

1. Construction (technical) of the paper plane. (33%)
2. Flight performance (distance/time aloft) (34%)
3. Compliance (33%)

1. Construction:

Paper planes must only be constructed out of one piece of paper: Standard letter size A 4 (8.5" x 11"). The sheet must be modified by folding only! No ripping, gluing, cutting, stapling or ballasting is allowed!

Paper planes have to be built on site on event day with the provided paper.
Time limit for building: 15 minutes. (Minor adjustments may be made later "on the fly".)

Ten sheets of paper will be provided to each participant and as many as ten airplanes may be built. However, only one plane per category, and a maximum of four planes may be flown in competition.

2. Flight performance:

There will be two rounds per competitor and category. Different planes can be used, The best attempt out of two per round will be scored.
A maximum of 2 invalid attempts are allowed per category

The distance

Is measured from the starting line to the furthestmost part of the plane after it has come to rest. It will be measured with a standardised tape measure or laser.
The measurements are the base point on the starting line and the point where the paper plane comes to rest. Results will to be counted in m/cm

Planes may strike inanimate objects (wall, ceiling, fixtures, floor,...) along the way.
We measure the North-South component of the horizontal displacement (e.g. if a plane gets hung up on the ceiling or flies into a corner, we will not measure a diagonal distance).

The Time Aloft

The time is measured from the the moment the plane leaves their hand to first touchdown.

3. Compliance

The aircraft must only launched by the competitor throwing the aircraft unaided from behind a straight launch line marked on the floor.
The participant needs to have both feet firm on the ground during the attempt
Stepping over the launch line during launch leads to an invalid attempt.
Touching the launch line or any point beyond during the launch, leads to an invalid attempt.
The competitor may move beyond the launch line, after the paper plane has come to rest.
For safety reasons, all competitors and onlookers including the person throwing the plane must stay behind a line on the floor.

A run-up or fast walk as part of the launch is not permitted, nor the use of ramps or like devices.

All entries must be received by 11th March 2023 by 9am at the Free Kid's Zone area at Manilla Show ground.
